about the pathologies of illnesses such as yellow fever and undulant fever milk sickness on the other hand some of its cures have come into vogue or else find modern scientific endorsement with examples from the text including the anti inflammatory properties of red pepper and the usefulness of the european plantain the volume has intrigued homeopathic practitioners through the years and attracted the interest of contemporaneous practitioners including for instance one doctor who wrote to the therapeutic gazette september 1881 to enthusiastically endorse its cure for gravel through gravel weed actinomeris helianthoides gravel translates to kidney stones

sir thomas colford and i with our little knots of agents and sub agents placed ourselves one on each side of the table waiting in respectful silence while the clerk dealt out the papers as a player deals out cards it was an anxious moment as any one who has gone through a closely contested parliamentary election can testify for ten days or more the strain had been great but curiously enough now at its climax it seemed to have lost its grip of me i watched the denouement of the game with keenness and interest indeed but as though i were not immediately and personally concerned

in the late nineteenth century as americans debated the woman question a battle over the meaning of biology arose in the medical profession some medical men claimed that women were naturally weak that education would make them physically ill and that women physicians endangered the profession mary putnam jacobi 1842 1906 a physician from new york worked to prove them wrong and argued that social restrictions not biology threatened female health mary putnam jacobi and the politics of medicine in nineteenth century america is the first full length biography of

mary putnam jacobi the most significant woman physician of her era and an outspoken advocate for women's rights jacobi rose to national prominence in the 1870s and went on to practice medicine teach and conduct research for over three decades she campaigned for co education professional opportunities labor reform and suffrage the most important women's rights issues of her day downplaying gender differences she used the laboratory to prove that women were biologically capable of working learning and voting science she believed held the key to promoting and producing gender equality carla bittel's biography of jacobi offers a piercing view of the role of science

in nineteenth century women's rights movements and provides historical perspective on continuing debates about gender and science today

in this historical tour de force roy porter takes a critical look at representations of the body in health disease and death in britain from the mid seventeenth to the twentieth century porter argues that great symbolic weight was attached to contrasting conceptions of the healthy and diseased body and that such ideas were mapped onto antithetical notions of the good and the bad the beautiful and the ugly with these images in mind he explores aspects of being ill alongside the practice of medicine paying special attention to self

presentations by physicians surgeons and quacks and to changes in practitioners' public identities over time porter also examines the wider symbolic meanings of disease and doctoring and the body politic porter's book is packed with outrageous and amusing anecdotes portraying diseased bodies and medical practitioners alike

this open access book has been written by ten belgian health care professionals nurses university professors and doctors specializing in palliative care and ethicists who together raise questions concerning the practice of euthanasia they share their experiences and reflections born out of their confrontation with

published writings of doctors stowe illuminates an entire world of sickness and remedy suffering and hope and the deep ties between medicine and regional culture in a distinct american region where climate race and slavery and assumptions about southernness profoundly shaped illness and healing in the lives of ordinary people stowe argues that southern doctors inhabited a world of skills medicines and ideas about sickness that allowed them to play moral as well as practical roles in their communities looking closely at medical education bedside encounters and medicine's larger social aims he describes a country orthodox of local social medical practice that

highly valued the art of medicine while not modern in the sense of laboratory science a century later this country orthodoxy was in its own way modern stowe argues providing a style of caregiving deeply rooted in individual experience moral values and a consciousness of place and time

although physicians make use of science this book argues that medicine is not itself a science but rather an interpretive practice that relies heavily on clinical reasoning in how doctors think kathryn montgomery contends that assuming medicine is strictly a science can have adverse effects she suggests these can be significantly reduced by recognizing the vital role of clinical judgment book

including michael jordan to express their improvisational talents but julius wasn't always as graceful and in control as dr j erving had a pristine image throughout his career and early retirement but he was far from a perfect man here he gives detailed accounts of some of the personal problems he faced or created behind the scenes including the adulterous affair with sports writer samantha stephenson which led to the birth of his daughter professional tennis player alexandra stephenson though his marriage survived that infidelity the death of erving's 20 year old son cory in 2000 in a tragic accident proved too much for the union to bear erving paints a raw heartbreaking

picture of the dissolution of his marriage as his wife turquoise began to blame him for his refusal to be paralyzed by grief for as long as she was their intense arguments came to a head when erving stepped out of the shower one day to find his wife holding a lamp in one hand and a vase in the other ready for a physical confrontation i knew somebody was going to get hurt and it wasn't going to be me he says he packed a suitcase and he and turquoise never lived under the same roof again erving's story is a tale of the nearly perfect player and the imperfect man and how he has come to terms with both of them it will appeal to readers on a sports level and on a human one
